

2026 RESOLUTION PROPOSAL PROCEDURES

State Committeemen interested in submitting a Resolution for the 2026 Mandatory Meeting must submit their drafts to the Resolutions Committee Chairman, Ian Murray.

Resolutions for the 2026 Mandatory Meeting must meet the following criteria per the Continuing Bylaws of the Republican Party of Arizona:

H.2. Procedures

Proposed resolutions, other than memorial, may be no more than 250 words long and must be submitted 45 days before the scheduled state party meeting in order to be considered by the resolutions committee. The title of the resolution shall not count towards the 250 word limit. The committee may initiate, recommend, modify, or reject any resolution or resolution title. Since the committee's purpose is to give the full assembly the benefit of its complete debate and mature judgment, motions to table or to close or limit debate will not be allowed. All resolutions submitted to the committee shall be sent with the committee's recommendations and vote count to each state committeeman with the notice of call of the meeting.

Submissions should be emailed using the attached Resolutions Proposal Form to Resolutions2026@azgop.com. The deadline to submit Resolution proposals is WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2025, 11:59 PM.

Proposals submitted improperly **may** not be considered.
